Categories	Notes	Amount
Competing	Category for competing rowers. Members may row and race in all boats and conditions subject to Captain's approval.	£260
Coxing/Coaching	This category is for those actively involved in the sport but who do not compete. May not row in club boats nor store private boats.	£45
Supporter	This category is for those not actively involved in the sport. Supporter members may be members of the Remenham Club and be club officers. May not row in club boats nor store private boats.	£45
Life	As above, after 2 years as any of the above membership categories.	POA
Temporary	Over 18s who use the club's bar and other non-rowing facilities for a limited period of time.	POA
Honorary	An unofficial category granted to a few members, based on previous rules. Honorary membership is at the discretion of the committee.	100% (Gratis)
Discounts		
Leisure Rowing	Discount for existing competing members who will not row at peak times. May row only at times and in boats determined by the Committee. Leisure members may not compete for the Club at open events. Members wishing to change to Leisure Rowing must apply to the committee. Not available to new members.	30%
Junior	Discount for members under 18 at 1st March 2007.	50%
Student	Discount for competing members over 18 years of age in full-time education at 1st March 2007.	50%
UB40	Discount for competing members holding a UB40 card at 1st March 2007.	50%
Senior	Discount for competing members over 65 years of age at 1st March 2007.	50%
Late starters – including Pubs & Clubs	Discount for members joining after 1st September 2007 or for beginners who join after taking part in the Pubs & Clubs Regatta. This extends membership to the end of the current membership year.	50%
